

RESOLUTION 12-2
ADOPTING THE Crow Wing COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE LOCAL WATER
MANAGEMENT PLAN
AS THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE Crow Wing SWCD

Supervisor Albrecht offered the following resolution, No. 12-2 and moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing SWCD has been an active participant in the development and all updates of the Crow Wing County Comprehensive Local Water Management Plan (CLWMP); and

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing County CLWMP included a map and description of the soil classifications within the conservation district; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing County CLWMP identifies the areas within the conservation district where erosion, sedimentation, and related water quality problems are the most severe; and

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing County CLWMP has been approved by the BWSR and has been determined to be in compliance with all laws and rules governing water in the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Crow Wing County CLWMP identifies high priority erosion, sedimentation, and water quality problems in accordance with BWSR rules and guidelines.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED:

THAT THE Crow Wing SWCD adopts the Crow Wing County CLWMP as its Comprehensive Plan for calendar years 2012, 2013,2014,2015,2016 and 2017.
